GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. Presenters and participants who participate in the offline Parallel sessions must attend the sessions on-site and do the presentation based on the schedule.
- 2. You can choose to join any parallel sessions and workshops you wish to attend.

PRESENTERS

- 1. Each presenter should check and follow CONAPLIN 15 schedule.
- 2. There are four parallel sessions: two sessions on the first day and two sessions on the second day.
- 3. Each parallel session is scheduled for an hour.
- 4. Each offline parallel session will be divided into 5 rooms.
- 5. There are 3 to 4 presenters in one room.

- 7. Presenters should use the laptop provided in the parallel rooms.
